7. Applicant must:
- Be a graduating high school senior or first year college student, not older than 21 years of age.
  - Be a resident of Kitsap County.
  - Have a profound interest in the performing arts with an emphasis in musical comedy theatre.
  - Must complete and mail an application which will be reviewed and rated (one-third of total score) - **Application must be received or postmarked no later than April 1.**
  - For the on-stage performer: Present a live audition (two thirds of total score) to a board of judges, in each of the three areas described below and in this sequence:
    - A comic monologue - one minute duration (memorized)
    - A dramatic monologue - one minute duration (memorized)
    - A song (3 ½ min. maximum), preferably from a Broadway musical show (memorized).  
**Please bring your own accompanist.**
    - It is expected that those auditioning for this scholarship will come prepared and dressed appropriately.
  - For the Abundis Musician/Dance /Technical support applicant: An interview will be scheduled. Eligibility for this scholarship includes participation in a CSTOCK production sometime during the past 18 months.
  - In addition to the audition or interview, applications will be reviewed and scored by the Board of Directors.
8. Please include with this application one (1) personal **letter of reference** from people who can comment on your character and talent. Letters are acceptable from teachers, clergy, and adult personal friends. Letters from relatives are not acceptable.
9. Please include with this application a personal letter, written by yourself, describing yourself, your talent, and why you should receive this scholarship. Letters should be at least one typewritten page.
10. Auditioning applicants are responsible to provide their own music and accompanist. A piano will be available for your use. Recorded music is acceptable but not preferred.
11. **This application, together with the letter of reference/recommendation, and the personal letter written by you, are to be mailed and postmarked no later than April 1 to:**
